We praise and thank God for the **seven (7) National Seminars** that were successfully completed across Kota Kinabalu, Kota Marudu, Miri, Kuala Lumpur, and Penang, with a total of **257 alumni graduates**.

These seminars reached diverse groups including NGO leaders, school leavers, parents and teachers, church and marketplace leaders, and international participants from across Asia. Notably, the MiDYA 3.0 RNS in Miri saw the **largest intake with 122 youth graduates**, while BMBCC seminars in Penang reflect **growing regional and cross-border partnerships**.

We thank God for the strong collaboration with churches, schools, and partner organisations, and for the lives equipped and transformed through these national seminars.

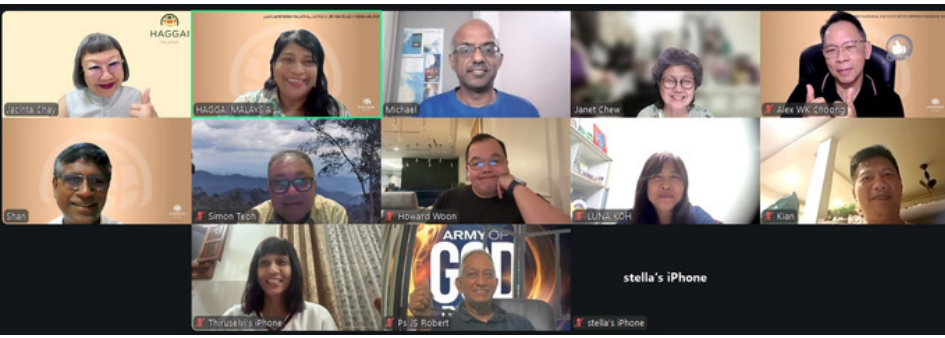

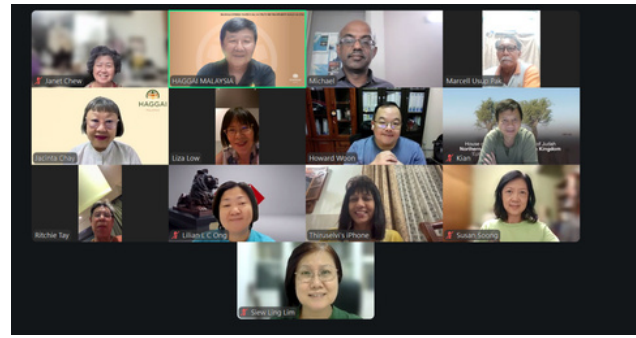

Breaking New Ground in Kota Marudu

Haggai National Seminar Expands to Northern Sabah

On 22-25 April 2026, a significant milestone was reached as the Haggai National Seminar was held for the **first time in Kota Marudu, Sabah**, at His Sanctuary of Glory. Located approximately 130 km from Kota Kinabalu, this seminar marked a meaningful expansion of Haggai’s mission into the **northern region of Sabah**.

Fifteen enthusiastic participants, supported by five dedicated facilitators, gathered for four days of learning, reflection, and spiritual growth. Many of the participants were **housewives serving as leaders** in their churches – **a powerful reminder that leadership in God’s Kingdom transcends titles and platforms.**

A Transformational Experience

Throughout the seminar, participants were deeply impacted as they engaged with the facilitators’ teachings. The sessions were not merely informative – they were truly life-shaping, helping to:

- **Clarify evangelism goals** and personal calling
- **Deepen awareness** of the world’s need for the Gospel
- **Strengthen leadership responsibility** in raising future generations
- **Instill discipline** in personal and ministry life
- **Cultivate compassion** for those in need

The seminar created a space where hearts were stirred and minds were renewed – equipping participants with both vision and practical tools for ministry.

From Reluctance to Calling

Taking **two weeks of leave** to attend Haggai Leader Experience (HLE)? **Certainly not** – that was my immediate and instinctive response when I was first approached about participating. Yet, despite my initial doubts and hesitation, I committed in faith, trusting that by March 2026 I would be in Port Dickson to take part in the HLE. **This was April 2025.**

Season of Preparation

Fast forward to February 2026. As I engaged with the 2 weeks of pre-devotional materials, I began to notice a recurring pattern: when God calls individuals, He first prepares them before entrusting them with their assignments. **Truly God prepares those He calls.** During this period, I gained a deeper clarity regarding my life's purpose. Throughout the past year, God had affirmed to my family and me that 2025 would be a year of reset. Entering 2026, I carried an expectation that God would begin something new in my life, and the HLE became a meaningful avenue through which He prepared me for what lies ahead.

Divine Connections

It was also by **divine appointment** that the three other men present here were part of my Haggai journey, which began at the Malaysia National Seminar in March 2025. Furthermore, God brought together a brother from Laos and myself in this shared HLE adventure, a powerful testimony of His grace and goodness.



Renewed Identity and Mission

Through the HLE, God has planted within me a purpose far greater than myself. I have become more intentional in considering how each of my actions can effectively present and demonstrate the Gospel. I no longer see my ministry as confined to my family and church. Where I once viewed myself as a lighthouse—stationary and visible to those nearby—that perspective has been reshaped. **I now see myself as a “floating vessel of light”**: one that not only reflects the light of Christ but also carries tangible burdens. These burdens may take the form of meeting physical, financial, or emotional needs in the workplace and within the community around me.

I am confident that God has been preparing me through my past experiences, and I trust that He will continue to shape and refine me for the unique assignment ahead. Thank you for being such an encouragement and example. Your life and leadership truly stir something deeper in me – to serve Him more faithfully, more intentionally, and with greater impact.”

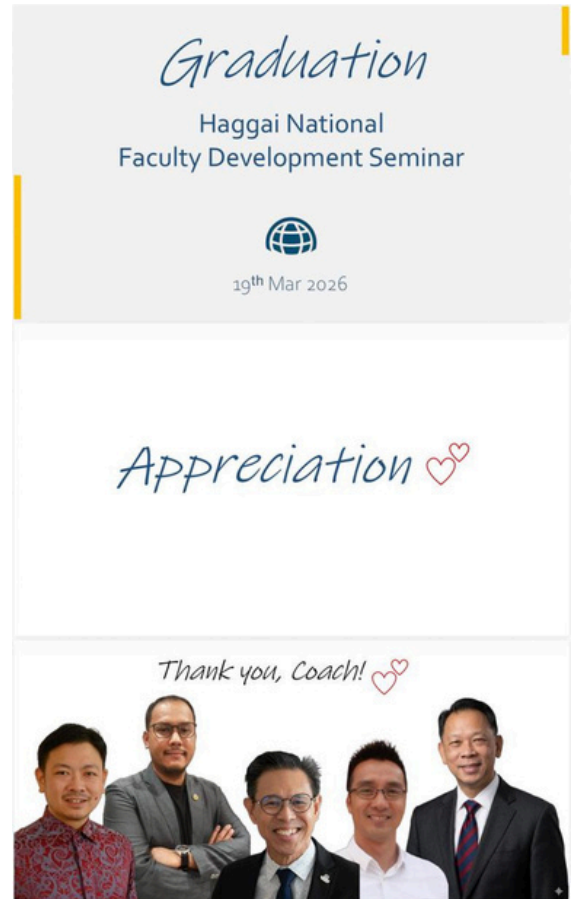
